Each section in this chapter describes a tree inventory program. The following explains section format.

The legend to the right indicates operating systems, installation media formats, and mouse compatibility options indicated as graphics at the beginning of each section. These are included so the reader can determine if the software is compatible with their computer system.

The first page in each section includes software provider services, policies and fees for technical support, contact information, and software costs. Computer system requirements as indicated by the software provider are noted along with the computer systems that were used with the program in this study. All MS-DOS® (Microsoft Disk Operating System) based programs were used in the Windows® environment.

Program directory size before and after data entry is shown along with the approximate amount of hard disk space required by the program for 1,000 tree sites. Estimated required hard disk space was derived by subtracting the directory size after program installation from its size after data entry. The difference was divided by the number of tree sites entered and the quotient was multiplied by 1,000. The estimates for required hard disk space show minimum values which will most likely increase when work order, request, and other data are added to existing tree sites over time.

The remainder of each section describes program configuration, data entry, and report options. Figures are included to exemplify the above as well as report output.
